Albania's electricity transmission system consists of lines with a voltage level of 110 kV, 150 kV, 220 kV and 400 kV, the respective substations at these voltage levels, and all equipment, the functions of which are included in the power transmission electrical.

How many mobile connections are there in Albania?

In January 2021, there were 131.2% of the total population, or equivalent to over 3.3 million, mobile connections in Albania. Note: many people have more than one mobile connection, so figures for mobile connections may exceed 100% of the total population.
