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Who owns block stp02 offshore Sao Tome & Principe?

The French player has signed an agreement with the Agencia Nacional do Petróleo de S. Tomé e Príncipe (ANP-STP) to get a hold of a 60% stake and operatorship in Block STP02 offshore Sao Tome and Principe. As a result, the remaining interests will be held by the existing license holders, Sonangol (30%) and ANP-STP (10%).

This allows the Brazilian behemoth to re-open its African chapter, following years of absence after it exited Nigeria due to the sale of its interests in three offshore fields.
