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What is a glass-glass solar panel?

Glass-glass module structures (Glass Glass or Double Glass) is a technology that uses a glass layer on the back of the modules instead of the traditional polymer backsheet. What is a double glass solar panel?

Traditional solar panels typically feature a glass front and a polymer backsheet. In contrast, double glass modules replace the polymer layer with another glass sheet, creating a robust sandwich structure. At IBC SOLAR, we use 2,0 mm x 2,0 mm glass layers, whereas some other market offerings use thinner 1,6 mm x 1,6 mm layers.

Are bifacial solar panels PID-free?

It is a PID-free product as it does not allow the effect of the back foil on inductive degeneration. Most common configuration for Bifacial Solar Panels is double glass. And even when bifacial modules have not have Fire Class A, still is much more protect anti-fire than standard back sheet modules.

Why are double glass solar panels bifacial?

Thermal stability: The identical thermal expansion coefficients of the glass layers minimize stress on solar cells during temperature fluctuations. Dual-sided energy Capture: Many double glass modules are bifacial, allowing them to harness sunlight from both sides.
