Main cost factors include distance, volume, delivery method, and optional services like insurance, customs, or packing.

How much does it cost to move a container?

On average, moving a container within the United States costs around \$2,000-\$5,000. For international moves, the price of a shipping container can be from \$5,000 to \$10,000. If you're moving an empty container over a short distance (under 200 miles), you may pay between \$500 and \$1000.

Is a 40 ft container a good value?

They are graded as Cargo Worthy, Watertight or As Is. As previously mentioned, Container Management, Inc. never sells As-Is condition containers. As a general rule of thumb, a used 40-foot standard container will be priced around 30% more than a used 20-foot container, of the same condition.
