How many substations does Ethiopian Electric Power have?

To support this extensive transmission network, Ethiopian Electric Power oversees 192 substations, strategically distributed throughout the country. These substations operate within a voltage range of 132 kV to 500 kV.

Is Addis Ababa a family duty station?

Addis Ababa, located in Ethiopia, is not classified as a non-family duty station. It is classified as a "B" duty station, with "A" being the least and "E" the most difficult. The hardship allowance is paid for assignments at B, C, D, and E duty stations, including Addis Ababa (Ethiopia).
